



Conflict Minerals Declaration

All Orbel Corporation products are “DRC Conflict Free”

In accordance with the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, Section 1502, companies that are publicly traded in the US and governed by the Securities & Exchange Commission (SEC) must report on the source of 3TG minerals - tantalum, tin, tungsten and gold found in their products or utilized in its manufacture. Companies that make products for which 3TG minerals (tantalum, tin, tungsten and gold) are necessary to the functionality or production of that product must assess their supply chains and publically report on the source of these minerals if they are sourced from the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) or adjoining countries or if they are from recycled or scrap sources.

Although Orbel Corporation is not directly subject to this law, we are providing this declaration to our customers to help them comply with their obligations relative to this law.

This document declares that based on customer’s unique requirements, products manufactured by Orbel Corporation may contain one or more conflict minerals and that these minerals are necessary to the functionality of the products manufactured. Based upon research conducted by Orbel Corporation and in conjunction with our suppliers, this document declares that all conflict minerals used in Orbel Corporation products do not originate in the Democratic Republic of the Congo or an adjoining country or come from a recycler or scrap supplier.
